## Old Business:

• Safety Update:

-Field and Noon Hour Supervision in zones - there is full coverage but volunteers are welcome.

-Many people wanted to know what was happening and clarification of policies has helped eliminate some concerns.

-Communication of what is going on is very important and helps parents.

-Some families are communicating with the city about the possibility of a fence. -The city will need to assess this. This is a community issue. There is a joint use agreement for the grass/field area of the park. There is nothing the school itself can do about fencing this park.

-Safety Committee - proposal for a meeting or group discussion on this issue. -Some parents have raised concerns about the security measures implemented for the daycare:

-Such as locking the doors prior to IKT's school day. The doors at the end of the daycare hallway have always been locked during school hours between 9 and 330 pm.

-Now that the doors are always locked the changes have changed the "seamless" nature of the daycare for these families.

-This is especially a challenge on bad weather days.

-These parents request a reconsideration of this policy or further consultation.
