## • **<u>Principal's Report</u>** ~ Shelley

- 1. Fun Fair confirm hot lunch/hot dogs for kids and to feed the kids from Fraser Middle coming to help.
- 2. Fun Fair Raffle Baskets teachers want to know if parents can help put together? Some might have a lot of collections and need more than one basket made.

- 4. Ready Set Learn may 8<sup>th</sup> we are at 56 kindergarten for fall, this year we are at 44. Covid Babies! Likely will have 3 K classes, no splits for K.
- 5. School Goals for next year staff have been working. Each school needs to have 3 goals in literacy, numeracy, and social/emotional learning. For literacy we have been focusing on writing. Will be intentional about it next year. Might involve extra practice for cursive writing as new studies have been showing link between learning and cursive, can be very helpful with boys especially. Numeracy = number sense, understanding how a number is created and what it signifies. Social/emotional learning: accountability with kids. Has been challenging to talk through with kids and with parents. Seems to be a growing problem and that as group of adults losing respect that needs to be happen.

### • **<u>Treasurer's Report</u>** ~ Amy

- Leftovers in budget for the year we can allocate if necessary.
- Don't have final cost for Stillwood and Bridal Falls fieldtrip for grade 5s yet.
- Not all teachers have used the full \$200 allocation for classroom supplies etc from PAC. They have until May 31<sup>st</sup> to spend.
